

**MINUTES - TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
TOWN OF BELVIDERE

JUNE 27, 2022**

Mayor Kennedy opened the regular meeting of the Belvidere Town Council with the Pledge of Allegiance and the following notice was read in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act: In accordance with Chapter 231 of the Public Laws of 1975, notice of this meeting was given by way of notice filed with the Express Times Warren County NJ Zone and/or the Express-Times or Newark Star Ledger, filed in the Municipal Clerk's Office and posted in the Belvidere Town Hall, 691 Water Street, Belvidere NJ. This meeting was also advertised in accordance with the law as a virtual ZOOM meeting with instructions to the public for attendance and comment.

Adoption of Minutes:

A motion was made by Councilman Roth, seconded by Councilman Matlock and carried to adopt the May 23, 2022 regular and executive meeting minutes of the Belvidere Town Council.

Presentations:

Susan Mazzitelli - FEMA home elevation project

Review of grant program. Restricted deed will be required and all have received historic review. All Ms. Mazzitelli's costs are reimbursed through the grant. Initially four homes were approved, one on Water St., two on Depue St. and one on Wall St. The Wall St. home has withdrawn from the program. The homeowners of the Wall St. property were considering opting back into the program but FEMA has advised that is not possible. There was discussion of the Town financing the reimbursement to the homeowners until the FEMA reimbursement comes in. This would require an agreement between the homeowners and the Town. No decision was made at this time.

Kathy Schettini - Motion Picture Initiative

Ms. Schettini attended, on behalf of the Town, a program offered by Warren County regarding Belvidere possibly being considered for filming and film locations, etc.

A motion was made by Councilman Roth, seconded by Councilwoman Miers and carried to appoint Kathy Schettini as liaison for the Town of Belvidere in regards to the Motion Picture Initiative.

Public Comment:

There was no public comment at this time.

Committee Reports:

Councilman Mitchell - no report at this time

Councilwoman Miers - six-month budget status will be provided for the next Council meeting.

Councilwoman Napolitani - our new patrolman is now on duty. OT is down from prior months. The Deputy Court Administrator has successfully completed both the oral and written portions of the court administrator certification.

Councilman Matlock - Environmental and Shade Tree are working well together.

Councilman Zmigrodski - no report at this time.

Councilman Roth - DSM has offered to repair the "Belvidere" sign on Route 46. CCB very busy

with over 1200 visitors so far this year. Problems with the air conditioning system at the CCB. Being reviewed by contractors.

An updated list of events for Heritage Days was provided to Council.

A motion was made by Councilman Roth, seconded by Councilman Matlock and carried authorizing an expansion of street closures for Heritage Days to accommodate the horse and carriage ride and also Council's acceptance of plan A or B as provided by the Heritage Days Committee with notification to the PD and DPW one month before the event.

Pool memberships up 10%. Many upgrades in the Snack Shack. Thank you to Jason Stout for his efforts in getting the facility prepared for the start of the season. A water accident occurred last week. Mayor Kennedy advised that there was a great response from the staff, EMS, Fire and PD and that the accident victim is fine.

NPP moving forward with painting the planters. Some plans have been submitted to the State regarding the Riverfront area.

A grant has been received from a national organization for the installation of a bike lane. 23,000 applications were reviewed and Belvidere was one of nine in New Jersey that were chosen.

A motion was made by Councilman Roth, seconded by Councilwoman Napolitani and carried authorizing the installation of a bike lane on the south side of Oxford Street from the Belvidere/White Township border to Hardwick Street.

A committee of Councilman Roth, Joe Kennedy, Jr., Virginia Walton and Tammy Koop reviewed options for a new website for the Town. The committee has recommended Civic Plus for their experience, expertise, flexibility, security and support. This company deals primarily with municipal websites and has many in the State.

A motion was made by Councilman Roth and seconded by Councilman Mitchell approving a contract with Civic Plus for the development and maintenance of a new website for the Town of Belvidere at a cost of \$3,800 annually with a 5% annual increase.

ORDINANCE NO. O2022x02

TOWN OF BELVIDERE

WARREN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A REVISION AND CODIFICATION OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BELVIDERE

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Belvidere, County of Warren,

State of New Jersey, as follows:

§ 1-1. Code adopted; existing ordinances continued.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-4, the ordinances of the Town of Belvidere of a general and permanent nature adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Belvidere, as revised and codified and consisting of Chapters 1 through 505, together with an Appendix, are hereby approved, adopted, ordained and enacted as the Code of the Town of Belvidere, hereinafter referred to as the "Code." The provisions of the Code, insofar as they are substantively the same as those of the ordinances in force immediately prior to the enactment of the Code by this ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such ordinances and not as new enactments. This ordinance and the Code adopted hereby shall supersede and replace the 1987 Code of the Town of Belvidere, as amended and supplemented.

§ 1-2. Code on file; additions and amendments.

A. A copy of the Code has been filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk and shall remain there for use and examination by the public until final action is taken on this ordinance. Following adoption of this ordinance, such copy shall be certified to by the Clerk of the Town of Belvidere by impressing thereon the Seal of the Town, as provided by law, and such certified copy shall remain on file in the office of the Town Clerk, to be made available to persons desiring to examine the same during all times while said Code is in effect.

B. Additions or amendments to the Code, when adopted in such form as to indicate the intent of the Town Council to make them a part thereof, shall be deemed to be incorporated into such Code so that reference to the "Code of the Town of Belvidere" shall be understood and intended to include such additions and amendments.

§ 1-3. Notice; publication.

The Clerk of the Town of Belvidere shall cause notice of the passage of this ordinance to be given in the manner required by law. The notice of passage of this ordinance coupled with filing of the Code in the office of the Town Clerk as provided in § 1-2 shall be deemed, held and considered to be due and legal publication of all provisions of the Code for all purposes.

§ 1-4. Severability.

Each section of this ordinance and of the Code and every part of each section is an independent section or part of a section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

§ 1-5. Repealer.

A. Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions contained in the Code adopted by this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeal shall only be to the extent of such inconsistency, and any valid legislation of the Town of Belvidere which is not in conflict with the provisions of the Code shall be deemed to remain in full force and effect.

B. The following ordinances have been excluded from the Code and are specifically repealed:

- (1) Ordinance No. 87-11, 1987 Code adoption, adopted August 3, 1987, as amended and supplemented.
- (2) Former Chapter 24, Health, Board of, of the 1987 Code.
- (3) Former Chapter 25, Local Assistance Board, of the 1987 Code.
- (4) Former Chapter 101, Indigent Persons, Article I, Burial, of the 1987 Code.

§ 1-6. Ordinances saved from repeal.

The adoption of this Code and the repeal of ordinances provided for in § 1-5 of this ordinance shall not affect the following ordinances, rights and obligations, which are hereby expressly saved from repeal:

- A. Any ordinance adopted subsequent to December 13, 2021.
- B. Any right or liability established, accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of this ordinance or any action or proceeding brought for the enforcement of such right or liability.
- C. Any offense or act committed or done before the effective date of this ordinance in violation of any legislative provision or any penalty, punishment or forfeiture which may result therefrom.
- D. Any prosecution, indictment, action, suit or other proceeding pending or any judgment rendered prior to the effective date of this ordinance, brought pursuant to any legislative provision.
- E. Any franchise, license, right, easement or privilege heretofore granted or conferred.
- F. Any ordinance providing for the laying out, opening, altering, widening, relocating, straightening, establishing of grade, changing of name, improvement, acceptance or vacation of any right-of-way, easement, street, road, highway, park or other public place or any portion thereof.
- G. Any ordinance or resolution appropriating money or transferring funds, promising or guaranteeing the payment of money or authorizing the issuance and delivery of any bond or other instruments or evidence of the Town's indebtedness.
- H. Ordinances authorizing the purchase, sale, lease or transfer of property or any lawful contract, agreement or obligation.
- I. The levy or imposition of taxes, assessments or charges or the approval of the municipal budget.
- J. The dedication of property or approval of preliminary or final subdivision plats.
- K. All currently effective ordinances pertaining to the rate and manner of payment of salaries and compensation of officers and employees.
- L. Any ordinance adopting or amending the Zoning Map.
- M. Any ordinance relating to or establishing a pension plan or pension fund for municipal employees. *{for additional entries, check EDIT NOTES and search on NI in DL and/or DT}*

§ 1-7. Changes in previously adopted ordinances.

- A. In preparing the revision and codification of the Town's ordinances pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-4, certain minor grammatical and nonsubstantive changes were made in one or more of said ordinances. It is the intention of the Town Council that all such changes be adopted as part of the Code as if the ordinances so changed had been formally amended to read as such.
- B. In addition, the changes, amendments or revisions as set forth in Schedule A attached hereto and made a part hereof are made herewith, to become effective upon the effective date of this ordinance. (Chapter and section number references are to the ordinances as they have been renumbered and appear in the Code.)
- C. Nomenclature changes. Throughout the Code, the following titles have been updated as follows:

- (1) References to "Zoning Board of Adjustment" have been deleted, where applicable, or changed to "Planning Board," where applicable, as a result of the

merging of the Planning Board with the Zoning Board of Adjustment, pursuant to Ord. No. 2008-10.

§ 1-8. Titles and headings; editor's notes.

A. Chapter and article titles, headings and titles of sections and other divisions of the Code are inserted in the Code and may be inserted in supplements to the Code for the convenience of persons using the Code and are not part of the legislation.

B. Editor's notes indicating sources of sections, giving other information or referring to the statutes or to other parts of the Code are inserted in the Code and may be inserted in supplements to the Code for the convenience of persons using the Code and are not part of the legislation.

§ 1-9. Altering or tampering with Code; violations and penalties.

It shall be unlawful for anyone to change, alter or tamper with the Code in any manner which will cause the laws of the Town of Belvidere to be misrepresented thereby. Anyone violating this section shall be subject, upon conviction, to one or more of the following penalties: a fine of not more than \$2,000, imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a period of community service not exceeding 90 days, in the discretion of the Judge imposing the same.

§ 1-10. When effective.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
